ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

Joshua Jensen-Nagle holds a BFA in Image Arts and Photographic Studies from Toronto Metropolitan University (formerly Ryerson University) and has built an internationally recognised practice over more than two decades. Represented by Bau-Xi Gallery in Toronto and Vancouver, Jensen-Nagle has exhibited at the Griffin Museum of Photography in Boston, the Glenbow Museum in Calgary, and internationally across North America, Europe, and Asia. His work is held in the collections of Cirque du Soleil, Microsoft, and numerous distinguished private collections. His signature large-scale archival prints, face-mounted to plexiglass on aluminium subframes, have become a hallmark of elevated contemporary residential and corporate collecting.

ARTWORK DESCRIPTION

Suspended Silence belongs to Jensen-Nagle's atmospheric interior series — a departure from his celebrated aerial beachscapes into the realm of grand European architectural spaces suffused with mist, candlelight, and a quality of arrested time. The Baroque ballroom or palace interior depicted here is rendered dreamlike through Jensen-Nagle's characteristic soft focus and tonal manipulation, the architecture simultaneously present and dissolving into atmosphere. The title captures the mood precisely — a held breath, a moment between events, a space waiting. The square format gives the composition an icon-like stillness that amplifies the work's contemplative atmosphere, while the plexiglass face-mount intensifies the luminosity of the candlelit interior.

CURATORIAL NOTES

Suspended Silence adds an important counterpoint to the collection's other Jensen-Nagle works — where the beachscapes and architectural interiors like *Wilhering Abbey* are defined by light and clarity, this work operates through atmosphere and mystery. Together the Jensen-Nagle works in the collection demonstrate the full range of the artist's practice. Edition 2 of 7 is an early and desirable impression.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Market Context: Jensen-Nagle's atmospheric interior series commands strong gallery pricing at Bau-Xi Gallery and international partners. The square 43 x 43 in format at edition 2/7 is among the most collectible configurations in his current output. Direct artist provenance with Certificate of Authenticity.
