#### ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

Thrush Byron Keats Holmes — his middle names drawn from the great Romantic poets — is a Toronto-based self-taught painter who has built one of the most distinctive and commercially recognised practices in contemporary Canadian art. Holmes entered the Toronto art scene with an immediate impact, opening the Thrush Holmes Empire on Queen West in 2007 and achieving overnight success. His work is held in the collections of Elton John's AIDS Foundation, Sony Music, DreamWorks Studios, and Def Jam Records. He has had solo exhibitions at PULSE Miami and the Mike Weiss Gallery in New York, and public installations at Galleria in the Park (Toronto) and Cleveland Cavaliers headquarters. Holmes works across oil, spray paint, neon, resin, and mixed media, combining traditional motifs — vases, nudes, landscapes — with a punk-inflected energy and glowing neon integration that is entirely his own.

#### ARTWORK DESCRIPTION

*Model Gucci* is a resin collage work in which torn Gucci campaign imagery, fashion editorial fragments, and printed ephemera are layered beneath Holmes's signature resin pour. The Gucci branding — visible as a compositional element rather than mere reference — elevates the luxury fashion register from source material to subject matter. The resin surface amplifies the chromatic intensity of the collaged elements, producing a material richness entirely appropriate to the brand it references.

#### VALUATION

#### CURATORIAL NOTES

*Model Gucci* is part of Holmes's highly collected *Model* series — a body of work that has achieved strong recognition among collectors of both contemporary Canadian painting and luxury-influenced art. The resin medium is one of Holmes's most distinctive material signatures and is central to the series's visual identity.

#### ADDITIONAL NOTES

**Market Context:** Holmes's resin model works are actively collected through Library Street Collective, Gallery Sonder, and international dealer channels. The fashion house titling (Gucci, Dior, Prada) gives the works exceptional cross-market appeal. Direct artist provenance with Certificate of Authenticity.
